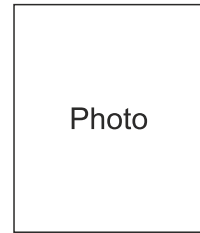

GENERAL GUIDELINES **FOR PARENTS / GUARDIANS :**

1. Parents are requested not to enter class rooms to see their children or teachers during school hours without permission of the Principal.
2. Parents are required to inform the school authorities if there is any change in their address or telephone numbers.
3. Leave for half-day should not be requested for the safety of the students. In case of emergency, written request from Parents or Guardians should be sent to the Principal and the Class Teacher should be informed accordingly.
4. Student failing to attend school due to illness is required to submit an application along with Xerox copy of doctor's prescription as early as possible (within seven days). In case the sick period exceeds seven days, guardians are required to inform the Principal personally.
5. Sick students will only be allowed to join the classes if he / she produce his/her medical certificate for the period of absence.
6. Attention of parents is drawn to the fact criticism of the teacher or school in the presence of their children should be scrupulously avoided because it causes them to lose respect for their teachers with the consequent failure from them. It further retards his/her progress.
7. Private tuitions by the school teachers are discouraged. Parents are requested not to approach them for this purpose.
8. Parents are requested not to send any gifts, sweets, or any other eatables to celebrate their ward's birthday. It will be appreciated if a book to the School Library or one sapling could be contributed.
9. Any communication made by the parent/ guardian should be addressed to the Class Teacher.
10. Any misbehaviour of a serious nature that-become public, is liable to bring about suspension or dismissal, even though it took place off the school premises.
11. Parents must keep the progress report in safe custody. If the report card is lost, a replacement will be made on payment Rs. 100/- .
12. Plan your holidays and tours as per your child's holidays.



14. Parents/Guardians are requested to affix their specimen signature in the space indicated below. No other signature will be accepted in the regularity records, report cards, test copies etc.
15. Parents are requested to co-operate with the school in its attempt to help their children's progress by paying attention to their regularity, punctuality and discipline and by taking interest in their performance in academics. They should check the diary every day and note the homework and other instructions in the diary and acknowledge the same by putting their signature. In case of small children, the parents are advised to check the bag of their wards to see if any notice/ invitation has been issued.
16. Parents are requested to sign the reports, test papers, teachers' remarks in the notebooks/School almanac.
17. Care must be taken of all school property and any damage caused by a student will be made good by the student concerned. In addition a fine will be imposed for the offence.
18. Leave may be granted to a student only on the following grounds.
 - a) In case of serious illness or death of a very near relative
 - b) For the condolence visits
 - c) To attend the marriage of his / her own brother, sister or brother sister of either parent.
19. The school cannot be held responsible for accidents minor or serious, on account of student's indiscipline or disobedience during school hours, excursion and while travelling.
20. At least 75% attendance is required or he / she may not be allowed to appear in examination.
21. Parents are requested to read the contents of the Almanac carefully and abide by the rules laid down by the School authorities.
22. As the medium of instruction in this School is English, students should be helped to follow their work easily and intelligently by a certain amount of regular conversation in English at home.
23. If you feel your ward is not making the desired progress, the concerned CT/Coordinator/Principal must be contacted.
24. Parents may please see that their child adheres to the School uniform strictly.



SCHOOL RULES

1. Every student must bring his / her almanac to school daily.
2. All the students should take pride in keeping the school clean.
3. While going to the assembly or their respective classes, students should maintain proper discipline. All the students must arrive at the school five minutes before the morning bell is rung.
4. Students should maintain courteous behaviour inside as well as outside the school. They should pay due respect to all the teachers and staffs. Bullying and use of foul language are punishable offence. They should greet their teachers when they meet them, even outside the school premises.
5. No student is accepted to leave the class without prior permission of the teacher concerned.
6. Edibles are not allowed in classes except in recess period.
7. It is advised not to bring valuable articles. The school cannot be held responsible for loss of any such article.
8. No student is allowed to leave the school premises without permission of the Principal.
9. A student recovering from any infections / contagious disease should produce a doctor's certificate of fitness to resume the class.
10. Student who has been absent on the previous day will not be allowed to attend his classes without permission of the class teacher and without leave application.
11. The school authorities reserve the right to amend or alter any of the school rules, fee rules, and other rules, if any, without assigning any reason.
12. Only English should be spoken in the school premises.
13. Shouting or whistling is not allowed in or around the school building. Throwing of anything at anyone is forbidden.
14. Other than Text Books or Library Books, no books, magazine, CDs cassettes should be brought to school.
15. Lending or borrowing money or any article is not permitted.
16. The school reserves for itself the right to terminate any student whose conduct is a bad example for others.
17. Bringing cameras / cell phone / fireworks /exploding crackers / splashing water or violation of these instructions can result in expulsion from the school.
18. School appointees should wear their respective badges daily, incase lost fine will be charged against the badge.
19. Students are allowed to come to school by bicycle but parents will be responsible for this. Bicycles must be locked. Students must not ride around in the school compound on bicycles.
20. Students must come to school in their prescribed uniforms only. This rule applies even when they come to school for purpose other than attending classes or even after school hours.
21. Students should be habitually clean and always neatly dressed. The School uniform should be worn on all working days and for all school functions. Students who are not in proper uniform will not be allowed to enter their class rooms.
22. In case of any electronic gadgets confiscated a fine of Rs. 2000/ will be charged.



23. All children are expected to attend School on the opening day after each vacation. Those absent because of sickness must present a medical certificate before they may be admitted to class.
24. Students are not allowed to wear watches to School.
25. Attendance is compulsory for celebration of National Days.

SCHOOL UNIFORM

The school uniform is a discipline in itself and should be adhered to strictly. The set pattern and colour should be strictly followed. All the students from Bal-Vatika onwards are expected to wear the school uniform as prescribed by the school on all working days & functions.

For Boys:

- ✓ Bal-Vatika: Navy Blue Shorts & Sky blue T-shirt; tracksuit set during winters. (Colours & design customised by the school).
- ✓ **For Classes I to IV:** Short sleeves shirt & Half-Pant; Full sleeves shirt & full-pant along with sweater for winters. Tie & Belt. (Colours & design customised by the school).
- ✓ **For Classes V to XII:** Short sleeves shirt & Full pant; Full sleeves shirt & full-pant along with Blazer for winters. Tie & Belt. **(Colours & design customised by the school).**
- ✓ School Socks & Black Shoes.
- ✓ House uniform as per the allotted house; white shoes & school socks.

For Girls:

- ✓ **Bal-Vatika:** Navy Blue Shorts & Sky blue T-shirt; tracksuit set during winters. (Colours & design customised by the school).
- ✓ **For Classes I to IV:** Short sleeves shirt & skirt; Full sleeves shirt & full-pant along with sweater for winters. Tie & Belt. **(Colours & design customised by the school).**
- ✓ **For Classes V to VIII:** Short sleeves shirt & Full pant; Full sleeves shirt & full-pant along with Blazer for winters. Tie & Belt. **(Colours & design customised by the school).**
- ✓ School Socks & Black Shoes.
- ✓ House uniform as per the allotted house; white shoes & school socks.
- ✓ White plain hairbands & White rubber bands for hair.

Note 1: The use of School I-Card/Monogram is compulsory for all.

Note 2: Wearing of any kind of jewellery is strictly prohibited. Girls can wear small studs. Long earrings, kadas, rings, chains, bangles, bracelets etc. are not allowed.

Note 3: For Girls, hair must be well braided (two-plaits), for short hair white hairband to be used only.

Note 4: Boys must have their hair well-trimmed, no spikes, gel, undercut etc. will be allowed.



SCHOOL TRANSPORT RULES

1. Transport facility will be made available on specified routes and designated stops only, at the sole discretion of the school management.
2. It is to understand that school transport, like any other vehicle on road, may get delayed sometimes due to traffic conditions, road conditions, or some technical fault. The parents should understand these practical situations and they should be at their best in cooperating towards the same.
3. The school transport routes are subject to change depending upon the requirements of the students and it is at the sole discretion of the school management.
4. For any addition or change in the route, the interested parent(s) may contact the Principal with a written request. The change may be allowed as per the feasibility and availability.
5. The school transport is an optional facility and it cannot be claimed as a matter of right by any student/parent. The school management reserves the right to withdraw the school transport facility from any student without assigning any reason whatsoever.
6. The school transport is arranged by the school for a complete academic session. Thus school transport cannot be withdrawn between the academic session.
7. In case any parent wishes to withdraw from the school transport facility for the next academic session, he/ she is required to inform the school in writing in advance for the withdrawal otherwise one month's transport fee will be charged in lieu of one month's notice.

DISCIPLINARY NORMS IN THE SCHOOL BUS

All students using the school bus are expected to be on the left side of the school bus at their designated bus stops at least ten minutes before the arrival time of the bus. The buses will not wait for the latecomers. During the dropping time due to safety concerns, students will not be dropped unescorted, instead, he/ she would be taken back to school and the parent would have to pick the student from the school. The availability of school transport to the learners is subject to adherence to disciplinary norms. Any misbehavior that distracts the driver is a serious violation and could harm someone.

Therefore, learners are required :

- a. to remain seated while the bus is in motion.
- b. to obey the instructions of Bus Driver/ In-charge.
- c. not to throw objects in or out of the bus.
- d. not to use indecent language in the bus with fellow pupils or the bus staff.
- e. not to damage the seats, curtains, etc. in the bus.
- f. not to fight or threaten other students in the bus.
- g. to abstain from any unruly behavior in the bus.

If any student is reported for any of the above violations, the school will take the following actions :

FIRST OFFENCE : Warning and report to the parents.

SECOND OFFENCE : Call the parents and suspend the learner's traveling on the bus for one week.

THIRD OFFENCE : School Bus facility shall be withdrawn with a fine.



ATTENDANCE

75% attendance is compulsory for the students for all Classes. Admit card and promotion is liable to be refused if they fail to meet this criteria.

WITHDRAWALS AND EXPULSION

- No fee will be refunded.
- The school authorities reserve the right to amend or alter any of the school rules, fee rules, and other rules, if any, without as signing any reason.
- A student who has been absent for 10 calendar days (including holidays) without due authorization from the principal will be considered as having left the school and his/her name will be struck off the rolls and may be readmitted.
- For transfer certificate, a written application must be submitted in the office of the Principal at least one month before the date when the certificate is required.
- Every student has to pay one month's fee as school leaving certificate fee apart from the usual monthly fee. If school authority disallows the continuity of the students, the question of fees for the next month does not arise. Transfer certificate will only be issued after the arrears of the school are cleared.

PARENTS TEACHERS MEETING

To develop the complete personality of the young pupil meeting between parents and teachers are held from time to time. It helps to facilitate better communication. The dates of PTM is mentioned in the academic calendar.

ASSESSMENT PATTERN

Promotion is based on the day to day work of the students throughout the year and also on the performance in term Examination.

EXAMINATION PATTERN

1. Weekly Test :

Weekly Test will be held for each subject of 10 marks

- It will be taken by the respective subject teachers during their allotted periods only.

2. Unit Tests :

- Unit Tests will be held for each subjects of 20 marks in each terms.



3. **Half-Yearly & Annual Examination:**

Half-Yearly(Term-I) & Annual Examination(Term-II) will be held for each subjects of total 60 marks for Bal-Vatika to Class VIII.

- For Bal-Vatika: The final result will be out of 100 marks where marks will be counted from Viva/Weekly Test (10), Activity(10), Unit Test(20) & Term Exam(60).
- For Classes I to VIII: The final result will be out of 100 marks where marks will be counted from Internal Assessment (20), Unit Test(20) & Term Exam(60).
- **Internal Assessment parameters differ across subjects. Detailed criteria and performance indicators for each subject will be clearly specified in the students' Report Card.**
- **For IX-XII examination will be conducted as per CBSE guidelines.**

EXAMINATION RULES

1. The academic session of the school shall be from April to March every year.
2. 75% attendance is mandatory for all students to be eligible to sit for the examinations.
3. Green Cards/Admit Cards will be issued to students only when all dues for the Term is clear.
4. No re-examination will be held for the students who remain absent in any of the test/examination.
5. Promotion is granted on the basis of continuous and comprehensive evaluation.
6. Parents are not allowed to withdraw their ward in the middle of the session. If situation arises they have to pay full session fee.

HOUSE SYSTEM

The system of grouping the students into different Houses has the inherent advantage of fostering loyalty, team spirit and healthy competition. The School has four houses to which the students are attached when they arrive in Class I. Inter House Competitions are organised in Sports, Cultural, Creative work and Academics. Emphasis is laid on the development of values through co-curricular activities. Cultural activities are streamlined in order to nurture the students a sense of pride for the motherland and its rich heritage and being part of the biggest democratic and secular nation in the world.

INVESTITURE CEREMONY

Formal Oath-Taking Procedure.
